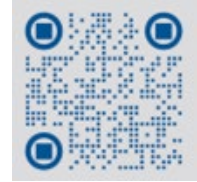

 - Prizes awarded to 1st, 2nd, & 3rd place.

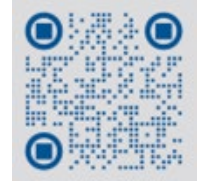

General Rules:

Canning Contest Rules:

- **Eligibility:** Open to general public
- **Labeling Required:** Each jar must be labeled with:
 - Contestant name & contact info (on bottom of jar)
 - Product name (e.g., "Spiced Peach Jam")
 - Date canned
 - Processing method (water bath or pressure)

Disqualification will occur if:

- The product is unsealed or improperly processed.
- There is visible spoilage (cloudiness, mold, separation).
- The recipe appears untested or unsafe.
- The jar or lid is cracked or damaged.

Baking Contest Rules:

- **Eligibility:** Open to general public
- **Registration Deadline:** All entries must be pre-registered by [date].
- **Entry Labeling:**
 - Name of baker (bottom of plate/container)
 - Name of recipe
 - List of all ingredients (important for allergens)
- **All entries must be homemade**
- **Presentation counts:** Use disposable or clearly labeled dishes you don't want returned.
- **Allergy awareness:** Include a full list of ingredients, but judges and organizers are not responsible for allergen exposure.

All entries may be displayed at the event, and the organizers may use photos for promotional purposes* Agreement: ***By entering the contest, participants agree to all rules & regulations listed above**
